Strong's Definition - κύριος kýrios, koo'-ree-os; from κύρος kŷros (supremacy); **supreme in authority**, i.e. (as noun) **controller**; by implication, **Master** (as a respectful title):—God, Lord, master, Sir.

Greek Parsing - Noun - **Vocative** – Singular - Masculine

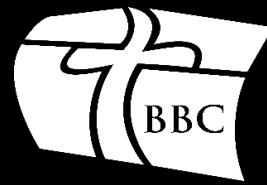

Strong's Definition - οὐ ou, οο; a primary word; the **absolute negative** (compare G3361) adverb; no or not:—+ long, nay, neither, never, no (X man), none, (can-)not, + nothing, + special, un(-worthy), when, + without, + yet but. See also G3364, G3372.

Greek Parsing - Adverb[·]

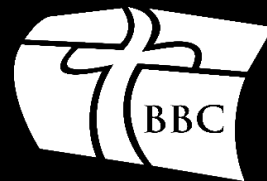

Philippians 2:8-11

•8 And being found in human form, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross. 9 Therefore God has highly exalted him and bestowed on him the name that is above every name, 10 so that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, 11 and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is **Lord**, to the glory of God the Father.

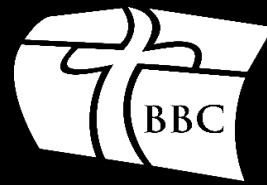
To call Jesus “Lord” is to say that He should be obeyed.



It is not merely a verbal expression of allegiance to Jesus, but rather readiness to act on His sayings.

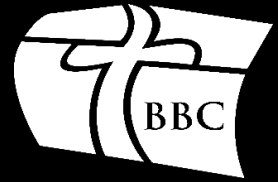

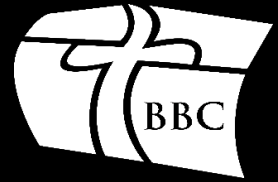
- Unless the Lord builds the house, those who build it labor in vain...

The **only goodness is when we are **Christlike!****

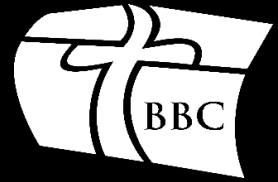

- But he answered them, “My mother and my brothers are those who hear the word of God and do it.”

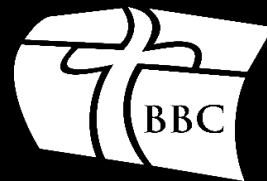
True family obey.

- But he said, “Blessed rather are those who hear the word of God and keep it!”

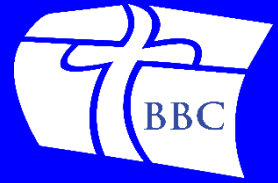

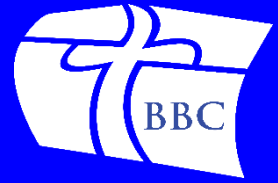
•12 Now if anyone builds on the foundation with gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, straw—

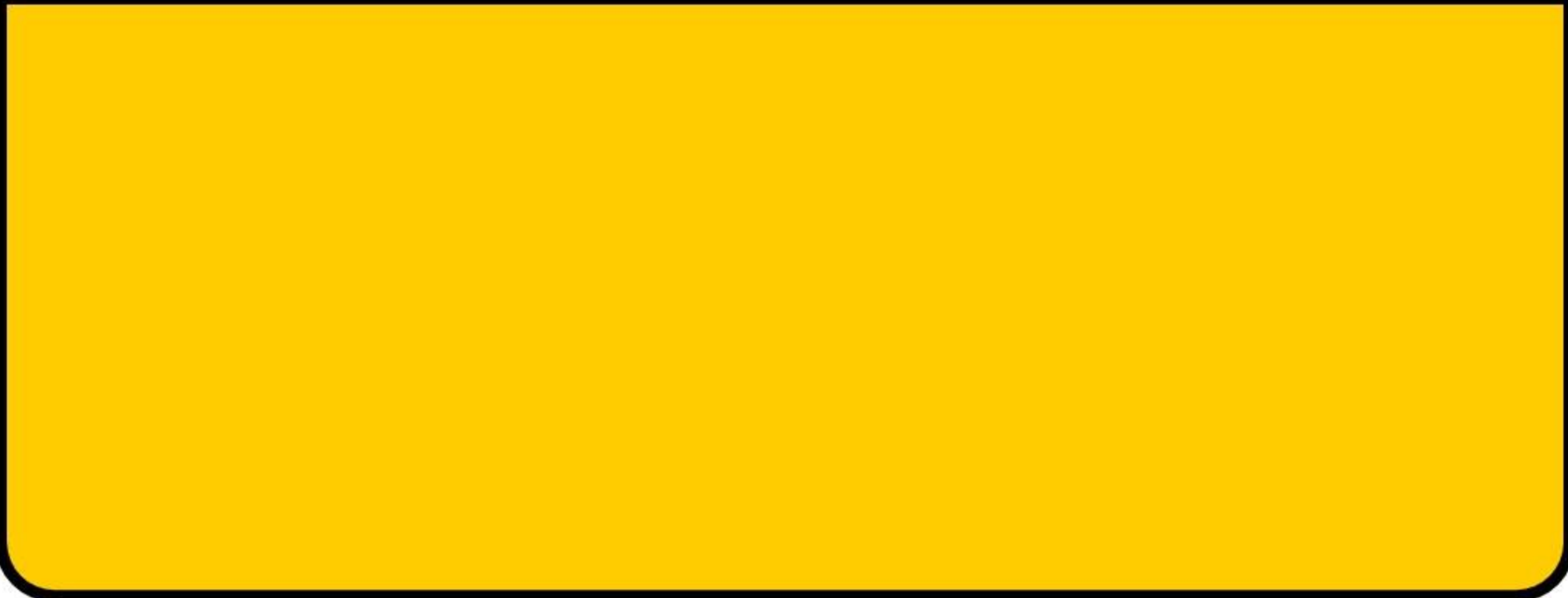

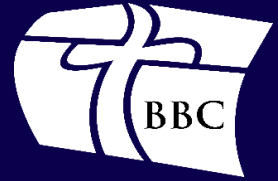

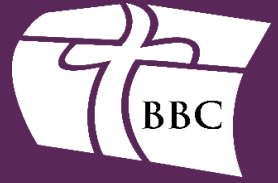
